# Field Trip 2023 Introduction:

The **Sustainable Coconut Partnership** in partnership with **Daemeter** will host the partnership's members and participants to the roundtable meeting 2023 to a field trip and study tour to visit coconut producers and farmers, to understand first-hand the challenges on the ground, how the flow of product moves from farm to processing facilities, and to visit farms.

The **study tour** is a good opportunity to interact with the Sustainable Coconut Partnership's team, members and peers. The trip aims to provide participants with a well-rounded understanding of the coconut industry in one of the coconut producing regions in Indonesia: Lampung – a convenient location from our roundtable meeting location. We'll unravel the intricate processes behind coconut production going from production facilities to traditional practices and engagement with farmers and key stakeholders.

The **study tour** is designed for anyone who is keen on learning – from the end-product manufacturers and ingredient manufacturers to coconut processors or those who are keen to learn more.

# Field Trip 2023 Concept

In Lampung, we will delve into industry dynamics and the choice of farmers between oil supply chains where the coprah (coconut meat) is shipped to other regions to be crushed and the full nuts supply chain where local processing facilities exist. We'll gain valuable insights through discussions with farmers and local traders on the various supply chains understanding their challenges and opportunities with the various intercropping practiced in the region.

We will visit **desiccated coconut, coconut milk production facilities** and engage with the local communities of farmers, witnessing the art of **traditional coconut sugar production** showcasing an alternative avenue for coconut products, shedding light on the unique role of local entrepreneurs.

Our journey will also extends to **coconut fibre based products** with a view on cocopeat/husk processing offering a glimpse into the broader coconut fiber industry.

An engagement with local authorities is planned to discuss the **regulatory landscape shaping Lampung's coconut industry**, setting the stage for future collaboration.

This holistic journey prepares us for an insightful roundtable in Jakarta, tying together our learnings and showcasing the multifaceted coconut supply chain.
